

Request for Comments

From time to time, Avista may request comments on posted proposals and respond to such comments pursuant to its Mechanism for Changing Business Practices (incorporated into Avista's Consolidated Business Practices). Accordingly, Avista asks for comments on the posted document titled *WECC Strawman Business Practice – Conditional Firm Transmission Service*.

Note - This WECC Strawman Business Practice describes the practices generally followed by Avista with respect to conditional firm service under its OATT and FERC Order No. 890, provided, however, in the event that such WECC Strawman Business Practice conflicts with the requirements of Avista's OATT or FERC Order No. 890, the provisions of Avista's OATT or FERC Order No. 890 shall govern. (For purposes of the *WECC Strawman Business Practice – Conditional Firm Transmission Service* and for purposes of this business practice, reference to "Conditional Firm Service" or "Firm Transmission Service with the condition that the Transmission Provider may curtail the service prior to the curtailment of other Firm Transmission Service for a specified number of hours per year or during System Condition(s)" or "Conditional Curtailment Option" shall be deemed to be references to the same type of Transmission Service under Avista's OATT.)
