

## **Business Practice Transmission Studies**

### **1. General**

- 1.1 This Business Practice contains a description of the transmission studies list being posted on OASIS, as well as information on how to obtain study results and/or base cases.

### **2. Studies List**

- 2.1 APS will post on OASIS a list of planning studies performed by the Transmission Planning and Engineering Department. Sensitivities and scenario analyses will not be listed separately.
- 2.2 This list will include studies completed on or after July 13, 2007.
- 2.3 Within 10 business days of the completion of a study, the list will be revised and posted on OASIS.

### **3. Study Results**

- 3.1 Study results (the written description of the study and its results) will typically be made available upon request.
- 3.2 Certain studies, as indicated on the studies list posted on OASIS, will only be available upon completion of the procedures outlined in the APS CEII Business Practice.
- 3.3 Persons interested in receiving a copy of a study result should contact the Transmission Planning and Engineering Department at [apstransmission@aps.com](mailto:apstransmission@aps.com) or 602-250-1652.
- 3.4 The charge for receiving study results will be limited to the cost of reproducing the material.

### **4. Base Cases**

- 4.1 The provision of base cases is governed by confidentiality requirements established by the Western Electricity Coordinating Council (WECC).
- 4.2 Persons interested in receiving a base case should first contact WECC.
- 4.3 After receiving permission from WECC to receive the base case, the Transmission Planning and Engineering Department should be contacted at [apstransmission@aps.com](mailto:apstransmission@aps.com) or 602-250-1652.
- 4.4 Base cases will be provided in GE PSLF format (consistent with the version utilized at the time of the study).
- 4.5 The charge for receiving a base case will be limited to the cost of reproducing the material.
