



NOTICE TO ALL ENTITIES

Those entities that e-tag transmission purchased from AZPS or for which AZPS is the host control area for the switchyard (Four Corners, Westwing, Navajo, etc) are hereby notified that effective 12/01/2004, AZPS will start to implement a more rigorous evaluation of the upstream and downstream scheduling entities (SE) on the e-tags.

Failure to provide the correct upstream and/or downstream SE on an e-tag may result in that e-tag being denied. At a date later in December, 2004 failure to provide the correct SE's adjacent to AZPS will result in the e-tag being denied.

In addition, those entities that have ownership in generation that is within the AZPS control area (Four Corners 4&5 and Palo Verde 1, 2, 3) must have registered at reg.tsin.com or modify the existing registration of Source to have AZPS be the control area, not their sinking control area (CA). As an example for Four Corners, PNMM shall change their source registration from PNM as the CA to AZPS as the CA. It is suggested that the Tag Approval Authority be set to the LCA so they are aware of what is happening to the dynamic generation that the LCA is receiving. The strongly suggested names for the generation (to differentiate from the switchyard for simplicity sake) are: **PALOVERDE** and **FOURCORNERS**.
