ATC remains zero for six months or longer

FERC Order 890 @ ¶371 requires a narrative with regard to monthly or yearly ATC values when ATC remains unchanged at a value of zero for a significant period, and will set that period at six months or longer.

(18 CFR §37.6(b)(3)(i)(C)(4))

When the monthly and yearly capability posted under paragraphs (b)(3)(i)(A) and (B) remain unchanged at a value of zero for a period of six months, the Transmission Provider shall post a brief, but specific, narrative explanation of the reason for the unavailability of ATC.
