

## Posting and changes of rules, standards, and practices

**Date: February 26, 2008**

**New Rev:** Created new document to delineate between overall OASIS business practice changes versus transmission planning business practices per Attachment K

In compliance with FERC Order 890, Black Hills Power, Inc., as Joint Tariff Administrator for Black Hills Power, Inc., Basin Electric Power Cooperative, and Powder River Energy Corporation, Transmission Providers, collectively known as BHBE, has posted or posted links to current rules, standards, and practices on BHBE's public OASIS home page and the BHP Company website. Each rule, standard, and practice is accessible to customers through the public OASIS site without the use of a certificate, allowing all current and potential customers' access to the terms and conditions of service. Folders containing links to current rules, standards, and practices are provided on BHBE's public OASIS home page. Lists of designated folders are as follows:

New Business Practices will be posted as soon as developed. If changes are being made to an existing Business Practice there will be a minimum of ten business days before the new Business Practice takes effect unless it is in all transmission customers' best interest to expedite the updated business practice. All Business Practices will include an effective date where appropriate and will include a notice on the OASIS. Comments to the Business Practices will be taken into consideration during the ten business days and can be made to the contact listed below.

As part of Attachment K, the transmission provider established a procedure to modify planning documents and therefore planning documents or business practices associated with open and transparent transmission planning will be changed based on that procedure. The procedure is named "Process for Modifying Planning Documents" and can be found under the Transmission Planning folder on the BHBE OASIS website.
