

Implement Changes to Requirements for Designating Off-System Resources

In compliance with FERC Order No. 890 ¶ 1476, the Transmission Provider is to implement changes to requirements for designating Off-System Network Resources.

As of July 12, 2007 (for preschedule day July 13, 2007) the Transmission Provider will require the following information be provided by all Network Customers with regards to their Off-System Designated Network Resources prior to Firm Network Transmission service being set-a-side.

The information below will be publicly posted on the Transmission Provider's OASIS system.

- Identification of resource as an off-system resource
- Amount of power to which the customer has rights
- Identification of the control area(s) from which the power will originate
- Delivery point(s) to the Transmission Provider's transmission system
- Transmission arrangements on the external transmission system(s) to include Assignment Reference Numbers or any other transaction detail that may be used by the Transmission Provider to verify that the third party transmission is Firm.

The information below will be required will but masked on the Transmission Provider's OASIS system.

- Operating restrictions (periods of restricted operation, maintenance schedules, minimum loading levels of resource, normal operating level of resource)
- Approximate variable generating cost (\$/MWH) for redispatch computations

Prior to the implementation and testing of the automated OATI DNR posting and request tool the above information shall be submitted to the Transmission Provider using SPR's form 07-01 and 07-02 (located on the Transmission Provider's OASIS site) via e-mail. If a customer has numerous resources to designate at once, an attachment to form 07-01 and 07-02 is available upon request in a spreadsheet format that has fields for all of the required information.
