NOTE: Entergy Nuclear Power Marketing, LLC (ENPM) contains a group that performs marketing activities for the competitive Entergy nuclear plants located in the northeastern and north-central United States (Entergy Nuclear Indian Point 2, LLC, Entergy Nuclear Indian Point 3, LLC, Entergy Nuclear Generation Company, Entergy Nuclear FitzPatrick, LLC, Entergy Nuclear Vermont Yankee, LLC, and Entergy Nuclear Palisades, LLC). ENPM, along with such competitive nuclear plants, hold FERC-approved tariffs that permit market-rate power sales. However, the entities do not conduct transmission transactions with an affiliated transmission provider (i.e., the Entergy Operating Companies). The FERC clarified in FERC Order No. 717-A that employees of an affiliate who do not transact with an affiliated transmission system are not marketing function employees (Order No. 717-A, para. 16.) And thus such entities are not included in the above list of affiliates of the Entergy Operating Companies that employ or retain "marketing function employees", as that term is defined in FERC Order No. 717.

Further, EAM manages the following affiliates that hold FERC-approved tariffs that permit market-rate power sales but that do not conduct transmission transactions with the Entergy Operating Companies: Northern Iowa Windpower LLC and Entergy's Joint Venture interests in Llano Estacado Wind, LLC.
