Dear Sir:

EPAct 2005 increased both the Commission's jurisdiction and its penalty authority, thereby increasing the importance of the Commission's enforcement program. The Commission's regulations allow Enforcement staff to conduct investigations relating to any matter subject to the Commission's jurisdiction.

FPL is hereby advising its Network Transmission Service customers that power sales coincident with use of Secondary Network Service may be subject to audit by the Commission's Enforcement staff. FPL recommends Network Transmission Service customers carefully review the Commission's policies regarding appropriate use and restrictions on use of Secondary Network Service as stated within FPL's Open Access Transmission Tariff and as discussed within the Commission's Orders 890 and 890-A.
