### **17.1 Critical Operating Conditions**

During critical or extreme operating conditions, Idaho Power will take actions to maintain adequate reserve margins on the system. These actions may include curtailment of schedules including denial of non-interruptible transactions sourcing from the IPCO Balancing Area.

### **17.2 Emergency Operating Conditions**

If Idaho Power declares an energy emergency condition, we will follow the Load Management procedures filed in Idaho Power’s Idaho Public Utilities Commission Tariff under Rule J.
