



Redirect Business Practice (Effective Date: 6/1/2008)

Based on Western's OATT sections 22.1 and 22.2 and clarifications in FERC Order 676, the following is the Western Area Power Administration, Rocky Mountain Region (Western RMR) Business Practice in regard to firm and non-firm redirect services for LAPT and CRCM Transmission Providers:

Redirects on a Firm basis

1. Western RMR will allow for the following service types to redirect on a firm basis:
 - a. Daily-Firm
 - b. Weekly-Firm
 - c. Monthly-Firm
 - d. Yearly-Firm
2. All Firm redirect requests will be treated in the same manner as any other firm point to point.
3. No additional deposits will be required for Firm redirects.
4. A request for a Firm Redirect is subject to all request timing requirements consistent with a reservation for Firm service of similar duration.
5. Redirects on a Firm basis shall have all the rights of the original Firm service, this includes the ability to redirect on a firm and/or non-firm basis.
6. All requests for firm redirects must be submitted on Western RMR's OASIS (WACM).

Redirects on a Non-Firm basis

1. Western RMR will allow for the following service types to redirect on a non-firm basis:
 - a. Daily-Firm
 - b. Weekly-Firm
 - c. Monthly-Firm
 - d. Yearly-Firm
2. A request for a Non-Firm Redirect is subject to all request timing requirements of the Secondary Hourly service type.
3. All requests for redirects on a non-firm basis must be pre-confirmed.
4. Transmission Customers shall have the right to request the TP to release capacity associated with a confirmed request to Redirect on a Non-Firm basis and reinstate that capacity to the Firm Reservation.



Rocky Mountain Region (WACM Balancing Authority)

5. All requests for non-firm redirects must be submitted on Western RMR's OASIS (WACM).
6. Non-firm redirect requests shall be submitted as Secondary Hourly from Alternate POR/POD
