

Renewal Policy and Procedure

Existing firm service customers with a contract term of one-year or more, have the right to continue to take transmission service from the Transmission Provider when the contract expires, rolls over or is renewed. This transmission reservation priority is independent of whether the existing customer continues to purchase capacity and energy from the Transmission Provider or elects to purchase capacity and energy from another supplier. If at the end of the contract term, the Transmission Provider's Transmission System cannot accommodate all of the requests for transmission service the existing firm service customer must agree to accept a contract term at least equal to a competing request by any new Eligible Customer and to pay the current rate based on MEAG's Open Access Transmission Tariff as of August 16, 2001. This transmission reservation priority for existing firm service customers is an ongoing right that may be exercised at the end of all firm contract terms of one-year or longer. The Transmission customer shall make an OASIS firm service request to renew the existing firm service by selecting the Request Type as "Renewal" at least sixth (60) days but no more than one hundred twenty (120) days prior to the expiration date of the existing Firm Service.
