

Reduction or Curtailment Procedure due to Requests from Balancing Authority or Reliability Coordinator

When the Reliability Coordinator or the Balancing Authority (SOCO) requests MEAG to reduce or curtail its confirmed reservations in order to mitigate critical conditions to return the system to a reliable state, the TMC operators shall comply with the directives unless such actions would violate safety, equipment or regulatory or statutory requirements. Under these circumstances, MEAG shall immediately inform the Reliability Coordinator or the Balancing Authority (SOCO) of the inability to perform the directive so that the alternate remedial actions can be implemented.

The reduction or curtailment is accomplished through the tagging process in compliance with NERC Transmission Service Priorities. The process is illustrated in the **Process E-TAGs** Section of MEAG's Reference Manual. The OASIS should be updated immediately following the reduction or curtailment in E-TAGs.
