**Re: Minnesota Municipal Power Agency's 2017 Annual Update of
Formula Rates – Informational Filing; Docket No. ER17-____-000**

Dear Secretary Bose:

Pursuant to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's ("Commission") orders in Docket Nos. EL12-351 and ER13-2379¹ and Section VI of the Midcontinent Independent System Operator, Inc.'s ("MISO") *pro forma* formula rate protocols under Attachment O of its Open Access Transmission, Energy and Operating Reserve Markets Tariff ("Tariff"), Minnesota Municipal Power Agency ("MMPA") on behalf of itself and its division, MMPA Transmission LLC ("MMPAT"),² hereby submits its annual update for charges pursuant to its formula rate for the period June 1, 2016 through May 31, 2017.

In accordance with the Commission-approved MISO Attachment O formula rate, MMPA's 2016 annual transmission revenue requirement ("ATRR") is based on actual cost data for calendar year 2015 as reported in MMPAT's 2015 audited financials. As required by the formula rate protocols, this submission is provided to the Commission for informational purposes only.

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II. BACKGROUND

In its May 2012 Order, the Commission initiated an investigation pursuant to section 206 of the Federal Power Act, 16 U.S.C. § 824e, to determine whether MISO's *pro forma* formula rate protocols in its Tariff were sufficient to ensure just and reasonable rates.³ The Commission found that MISO's *pro forma* formula rate protocols were insufficient to ensure just and reasonable rates, and directed MISO to file revised formula rate protocols which, *inter alia*, required transmission owners make an annual informational filing with the Commission.⁴ As the Commission stressed, these informational filings are to "be just that, informational."⁵ They "are not themselves rates and do not constitute changes in the underlying rate itself."⁶

In its March 2014 Order, the Commission required all MISO transmission owners to submit informational filings in separate dockets.⁷ The Commission directed MISO to provide notification of each transmission owner's filing through MISO's email 'exploder' list, and by posting the docket number assigned to each transmission owner's informational filing on the MISO website and Open Access Same-Time Information System ("OASIS") within five days of such filing.⁸

III. INFORMATIONAL FILING

Section VI of the formula rate protocols set forth in Attachment O to MISO's Tariff requires MMPA to submit to FERC, by March 15 of each year, an informational filing including information that is reasonably necessary to determine:

1. That input data under the formula rate are properly recorded in any underlying workpapers;
2. That MMPA has properly applied the formula rate and the protocol procedures;
3. The accuracy of the data and the consistency with the formula rate of the ATRR and rates under review; and
4. The extent of accounting changes that affect the formula rate inputs.

The formula rate protocols also require that the informational filing describe any correction or adjustments made during the information exchange and challenge periods, and must describe all aspects of the formula rate or its inputs that are the subject of an ongoing dispute under the challenge procedures. Section IV.F of the formula rate protocols further specifies that any changes or adjustments to the annual update resulting from the information exchange and informal challenge processes that are agreed to by MMPA will be reported in the informational filing and will be reflected in the annual update for the following rate year.

MMPA confirms there were no accounting changes that affected the formula rate inputs; nor were there any corrections or adjustments made during the information exchange or informal challenge process. MMPA did not receive any information requests on its update and received no challenges. Thus, there are no ongoing disputes under the informal or formal challenge procedures of the formula rate protocols.

MMPA has complied with the specific deadlines set forth in Section II of the formula rate protocol procedures:⁹

Pursuant to Sections III and IV of the formula rate protocols procedures, interested parties had until December 1, 2016, to submit information requests and until January 31, 2017, to notify MMPA of any specific informal challenges. Interested parties also have until April 17, 2017 (since April 15 is a Saturday) to submit a formal challenge with the Commission. MMPA did not receive any information requests and did not receive notification of any informal or formal challenges to date.

In accordance with Section VI, A of the formula rate protocols, MMPA will notify MISO of this informational filing and the docket number for posting on the MISO website and OASIS and for notification via the MISO email exploder list within five (5) days.
