Dear Secretary Bose:

Pursuant to Section 205 of the Federal Power Act,¹ Part 35 of the regulations of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (the “Commission”),² Nevada Power Company (“Nevada Power” or “NPC”) submits for filing a change to the collation value of Rate Schedule No. 122. In order to effectuate this change, NPC is making two filings today: one to cancel the current Rate Schedule No. 122 and another to submit the rate schedule with the correct collation value. The instant filing is the request to cancel Rate Schedule No. 122. This request is purely administrative and affects only the organization of the records in eTariff. It does not affect the content (rates or non-rates terms and conditions) of the governing Tariff.

This request is part of a series of filings made today with the Commission, the goal of which is to relocate the Open Access Transmission Tariff (“OATT” or “Tariff”) assigned to NV Energy, Inc. (“NV Energy, Inc. OATT”) to the NPC eTariff database and terminate the NV Energy, Inc. eTariff database.³ Sierra Pacific Power Company (“Sierra Pacific” or “SPPC”) has

filed a concurrence demonstrating its intent to be governed by the Tariff that is relocated to the NPC eTariff database.

I. Background

Nevada Power and Sierra Pacific are direct, wholly owned subsidiaries of NV Energy, Inc. Nevada Power and Sierra Pacific are regulated public utilities that provide retail and wholesale transmission service throughout Nevada. In December 2013, the Commission approved a corporate transaction whereby NV Energy, Inc. became a wholly owned subsidiary of Berkshire Hathaway Energy Company.⁴

In working with Commission staff to prepare certain filings submitted today to amend the organization of the Tariffs for NV Energy, Inc., Sierra Pacific, and Nevada Power, it became apparent that the collation value for Rate Schedule No. 122 of Nevada Power was incorrect. In viewing Nevada Power's OATT in the Commission's eTariff system, Rate Schedule No. 122 appears at the top of the listed Tariff sections, as opposed to being properly located between Rate Schedule Nos. 121 and 123. This requested change in collation value will allow the rate schedule to appropriately be located in numerical order. In order to correct this administrative error, Nevada Power is submitting today a cancellation of the rate schedule and subsequently re-filing the rate schedule with the correct collation value.

II. Description of Request

In the instant filing, NPC requests to cancel Rate Schedule No. 122 in order to re-file the rate schedule with the proper collation value. NPC requests Commission approval of this action in order to cause the rate schedule to appear in the Commission's eTariff system between Rate Schedule Nos. 121 and 123.
