



Posting Requirement: **Voluntary Consent**

Effective: November 26, 2008

Purpose

The purpose of this document is to satisfy the posting requirement of 18 CFR 358.7(c), pertaining to transmission customer voluntary consent of disclosure of non-public information to the transmission provider's marketing function employees.

Statement

The following consents have been made:

- SP Newsprint Co. has voluntarily consented, in writing, to allow PGE to share certain of SP Newsprint Co.'s customer information with PGE's marketing and sales employees. PGE did not provide any preferences, either operational or rate-related, in exchange for SP Newsprint Co.'s voluntary consent. (posted: June 4, 2004)

- Bonneville Power Administration has voluntarily consented, in writing, to allow PGE to share data concerning BPA's preschedule for loads located in PGE's control area with PGE marketing and sales employees. PGE did not provide any preferences, either operational or rate-related, in exchange for BPA's voluntary consent. (posted: June 22, 2007)

- PacifiCorp has voluntarily consented, in writing, to allow PGE to share data concerning PacifiCorp's Borderline Loads contained in PGE's control area with PGE marketing and sales employees. PGE did not provide any preferences, either operational or rate-related, in exchange for PacifiCorp's voluntary consent. (posted: June 22, 2007)

- Bonneville Power Administration has voluntarily consented, in writing, to allow PGE to share certain data concerning the provision of energy imbalance service to BPA with PGE marketing and sales employees. PGE did not provide any preferences, either operational or rate-related, in exchange for BPA's voluntary consent. (posted: April 15, 2008)
