



Posting Requirement: Job Titles and Descriptions of Transmission Function Employees

Effective: January 15, 2010

Purpose

The purpose of this document is to satisfy the posting requirement of 18 CFR 358.7(f)(1), pertaining to the identification of transmission function employee information.

Statement

The job titles and job descriptions of the transmission function employees of the transmission provider are as described:

DIRECTOR, TRANSMISSION & RELIABILITY SERVICES

Responsible for the operation of the Company's transmission system. Authorized by the Board of Directors to approve and execute transmission contracts. Manages all aspects of PGE's Transmission and Reliability Services Department and control area and their respective staff to maximize sales and revenue of transmission and ancillary services consistent with the Company's legal and regulatory obligations. Assists senior management in developing the overall Company strategy for competitive, open access transmission services. Represents PGE in negotiations, conferences, meetings and regulatory proceedings related to transmission restructuring efforts.

MANAGER, BALANCING AUTHORITY & REGIONAL PLANNING & EXPANSION

Direct the Transmission Preschedulers in the scheduling and delivery of transmission and ancillary services and manage overall operation of PGE's Balancing Authority. Act as a source of engineering and operations expertise for other PGE departments. Represent PGE interests in various industry organizations that focus on operation of the interconnected transmission system. Direct the Transmission Planners and ensure sound engineering practices are used in all transmission and generation interconnection studies.

SUPERVISOR, BALANCING AUTHORITY OPERATIONS

Direct the Balancing Authority Operators in the reliable day-to-day operation of PGE's Balancing Authority, the monitoring of power production at PGE generating resources and power delivery to PGE customers, and the scheduling and delivery of transmission and ancillary services.

ENGINEER, TRANSMISSION PLANNING

Responsible for coordinating and providing engineering support for the development of the transmission system under the supervision of the lead engineer. Performs power flow studies, investigates interconnection requests and transmission system impacts, assesses system reliability and undervoltage/underfrequency load shedding, participates in joint planning efforts with other utilities, and develops short-range and long-range transmission plans. Evaluates contracts and agreements affecting transmission interconnections, transmission service, construction and other documents.

SPECIALIST, BALANCING AUTHORITY OPERATOR

Reliably operate PGE's Balancing Authority, monitor minute-by-minute power production by PGE generating resources, facilitate energy deliveries to customer loads inside PGE's Balancing Authority, and perform real-time scheduling and delivery of transmission and ancillary services. Comply with applicable tariffs and rules, and with NERC/WECC reliability Standards. Direct other personnel to take actions necessary to ensure safe and reliable operation of PGE's transmission system.

SPECIALIST, TRANSMISSION PRESCHEDULER

Produce a day-ahead operating plan for PGE's Balancing Authority, process customer requests to use PGE transmission, and verify actual generation, transmission use, and wholesale transactions afterwards in accordance with PGE's OATT and posted business practices; approve E-tagged wholesale power transactions scheduled on reserved transmission. Comply with applicable tariffs and rules, and with NERC/WECC reliability Standards.

SPECIALIST, SYSTEM OPERATIONS TRAINING

Develops and administers the training program for the System Control Center operators to meet the certification requirements established by NERC. Also administer training needed for System Control Center operators to perform their work in adherence to FERC, NERC, and WECC regulations and requirements.

SPECIALIST, TRAINING COORDINATOR, OPERATIONAL COMPLIANCE

Oversees the System Control Center training programs. Supports the Transmission & Reliability Services compliance program with a focus on the System Control Center adherence to FERC, NERC, and WECC regulatory requirements. Provides backup shift relief for the Balancing Authority Operators.

MANAGER, TRANSMISSION CONTRACTS, OASIS AND OPERATIONS SUPPORT

Direct the staff responsible for transmission contracting. Duties include monitoring new generation interconnection requests and new transmission requests to ensure fair and open access under PGE's Open Access Transmission Tariff. Also monitors the provision of gas transportation under PGE's gas tariff. Directs staff responsible for operations support, OASIS and transmission billing.

ANALYST, TRANSMISSION CONTRACTS

Implements regulations pertaining to service over PGE's transmission facilities. Represents the Company in regional and national organizations that focus on creating policy to ensure Open Access and Standards and Protocol for the operation of OASIS. Negotiates, reviews and administers all contracts related to PGE's transmission facilities. Possesses a thorough understanding of FERC's wholesale transmission requirements and what impact that may have

on the Company. Proposes contract terms and conditions based upon a thorough business and regulatory analysis.

ANALYST, TRANSMISSION & GAS CONTRACTS

Implements regulations pertaining to use of PGE's gas transportation facilities. Negotiates, reviews and administers all contracts related to PGE's gas transportation facilities. Assists with electric transmission contracts. Proposes contract terms and conditions based upon a thorough business and regulatory analysis.

ANALYST, OASIS, BILLING & ACCOUNTING

Manages transmission data systems to ensure efficient system utilization. Leads research and proposes new solutions for data collection, billing, and after-the-fact accounting. Represents the Company in regional and national organizations that focus on creating policy to ensure Open Access and Standards and Protocol for the operation of OASIS. Acts as a lead for special projects as needed.

SPECIALIST, TRANSMISSION OPERATIONS

Ensures all transmission data systems are operating efficiently. Maintains PGE's OASIS and user operational aspects of tagging and transmission scheduling systems. Represents the Company in regional and national organizations that focus on technical issues related to Open Access and standards and protocol for the operation of OASIS.

SPECIALIST, BILLING AND REGULATORY REPORTING

Reviews and maintains control area accounts and prepares control area reports for the NWPP and WSCC. Provides back-up assistance for Pre-Schedulers.

MANAGER, SYSTEM CONTROL CENTER & SCADA

Manage the operation of the System Control Center in a reliable, safe manner by overseeing the performance of Transmission and Distribution dispatching work group. Assure generation and transmission assets are operated in a safe and reliable manner while complying with the WECC and NERC reliability standards. Manage the SCADA department to ensure the System Control Center has accurate real-time information and control functionality.

SPECIALIST, OPERATIONS SUPPORT

Provide a wide range of administrative and technical support for operations in the System Control Center.

SPECIALIST, TRAINING & RELIEF T&D DISPATCHER

Administers the System Control Center training programs. Provides backup shift relief for the Transmission & Distribution Dispatchers and the System Outage Coordinator.

SPECIALIST, TRANSMISSION & DISTRIBUTION DISPATCHER

Reliably operate PGE's transmission and distribution systems, monitor real-time electrical system flows and parameters, direct and authorize switching and tagging of PGE electrical equipment, and take actions necessary to protect electrical equipment and ensure public safety. Comply with applicable tariffs and rules, and with NERC/WECC reliability Standards. Direct other personnel to take actions necessary to ensure safe and reliable operation of PGE's transmission and distribution system.

SPECIALIST, OUTAGE COORDINATOR

Review, approve, and schedule equipment outages and switching sequences needed to support planned construction and maintenance on the PGE electrical system. Comply with applicable tariffs and rules, and with NERC/WECC reliability Standards. Direct other personnel to take actions necessary to ensure safe and reliable operation of PGE's transmission and distribution system.

WIREMAN/TRAVELING OPERATOR

Performs switching and tagging, testing and troubleshooting of substation equipment under the direction of the System Control Dispatcher.
