



**Notice:**            **PGE Proposing Removal of the Colstrip to Broadview and  
Broadview to Townsend Posted Transmission Paths**

PGE Transmission and Reliability Services (PGET) is proposing to deactivate the Colstrip to Broadview and Broadview to Townsend transmission paths, and to remove these paths from OASIS. These paths were posted to support proposed activity of a customer that has since withdrawn its requests that triggered PGET to post Broadview as a Point of Receipt ("POR") or Point of Delivery ("POD") between Colstrip and Townsend.

There have never been any confirmed reservations or scheduled transactions on these two paths. There is also no other Transmission Provider that has registered Broadview as a POR or POD, so there is no connecting physical segment at Broadview to enable any transaction designating Broadview as a POR or POD.

For the reasons provided above, PGET has concluded that the Colstrip to Broadview and Broadview to Townsend transmission paths should no longer be Posted Paths on the PGET OASIS. If, in the future, the paths become viable or are requested to be posted by any transmission customer, they will be activated and reposted on OASIS.

PGET seeks any comments or concerns regarding this proposal to deactivate the Colstrip to Broadview and Broadview to Townsend paths. If there are no objections to this proposal, PGET intends to deactivate the paths on May 1, 2009.
