

## Public Service Company of New Mexico Policy and Procedure for Redirect of Monthly or Long-Term Firm Point-to-Point Transmission Service

Public Service Company of New Mexico (PNM) has established the following policy for redirect of long-term firm point-to-point transmission service ("Firm Redirect Service"). In order to qualify to Firm Redirect Service, the transmission service customer must have either a confirmed monthly firm point-to-point transmission service reservation or a current long-term (one year or longer) firm point-to-point transmission service agreement with PNM.

Firm Redirect Service requests will be accepted under the following terms:

- Firm Redirect Service may be requested for monthly, weekly, daily or hourly periods.

The Firm Redirect Service request must have the **Related Transmission Aref** entered in the appropriate field, identifying the Monthly or Long-Term Firm Transmission Service Request ("TSR").

- Minimum submittal time required for Hourly Firm Redirect Service is 30 minutes prior to the hour in which the redirect is requested.
- Minimum submittal time required for Daily Firm Redirect Service is 10:00 A.M. MST on the day prior to the day for which Firm Redirect Service is requested.
- Minimum submittal time required for Weekly Firm Redirect Service is 10:00 A.M. MST two days prior to the day for which Firm Redirect Service is requested.
- Minimum submittal time required for Monthly Firm Redirect Service is 10:00A.M. MST on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of the month immediately preceding the month for which Firm Redirect Service is requested.
- Available Transmission Capability ("ATC") must exist on the transmission path for which Firm Redirect Service is requested for the entire duration of the Firm Redirect Service request.
- The transmission path being released under the redirect request will be posted as firm ATC on PNM's OASIS.
- Any use of the original path by the customer requesting Firm Redirect Service will be considered secondary service under the terms Section 22.1 of the PNM Open Access Transmission Tariff ("OATT").
- The customer requesting Firm Redirect Service will retain a right-of-first refusal on the transmission path released during the redirect. The customer requesting

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Firm Redirect Service will NOT have a right of first refusal on the path used for Firm Redirect Service

Firm Redirect Service shall be made in the form of a firm point-to-point transmission service request with notation in the comments section that the customer is requesting Firm Redirect Service and noting the path being released for the Firm Redirect Service.
