

Rollout Plan for PacifiCorp Customer Access to CMRI

The PacifiCorp EIM Entity and the ISO are working together to provide access to the ISO's Customer Market Results Interface (CMRI) to customers with non-participating resources (NPRs). The PacifiCorp EIM Entity will create specific groups of NPRs, based on each customer's Base Schedule Identification numbers (BSCIDs). Access for each user will be provided through individual user system certificates, which will allow each user to only access data related to NPRs each user is authorized to view.

The PacifiCorp EIM Entity requests information from NPR customers for each individual user by July 17, 2017. Please choose the appropriate process from the scenarios listed below:

1. If the CMRI user **currently has** an ISO user certificate for the Base Schedule Aggregate Portal (BSAP) or other ISO software, that is **managed by the PacifiCorp EIM Entity as the user access administrator (UAA)**, the PacifiCorp EIM Entity will need the following information:
 - a. Name of user
 - b. E-mail address of user
 - c. Name of each NPR to which user requests access
 - d. BSCID of each NPR to which user requests access
 - e. Name of the user's existing ISO certificate
2. If the CMRI user **currently has** an ISO user certificate that is **managed by a third-party UAA**, the requesting user must **request access from its third-party UAA** (providing the same information a. through e., under item 1. above to the UAA). After creating the certificates, the third-party UAA will then need to follow the Endorse User Process¹ with the PacifiCorp EIM Entity UAA to obtain access to CMRI.
3. If the CMRI user **does not** have an ISO user certificate and the requesting user's organization **uses the PacifiCorp EIM Entity UAA to administer ISO certificates**, the PacifiCorp EIM Entity will need the following information:
 - a. Name of user
 - b. E-mail address of user
 - c. Name of each NPR to which user requests access
 - d. BSCID of each NPR to which user requests access
4. If the CMRI user **does not** have an ISO user certificate and the requesting user's organization **uses a third-party UAA to administer ISO certificates**, the requesting user must **request access from its third-party UAA** (providing the same information a. through d., under item 3. above to the UAA). After creating the certificates, the third-party UAA will then need to follow the Endorse User Process with the PacifiCorp EIM Entity UAA to obtain access to CMRI.
