

PSEI posted a document titled Change in Windridge-MIDCRemote TTC in ATC folder on February 7, 2008. This document cited the first amendment to the January 2008, Puget Sound Energy (PSE) and Public Utility District No 2 of Grant County, Washington (GCPD) Interconnection and Facilities Agreement #340-2086. The amendment revised Exhibit C to the agreement to reflect the revised operating practice to use a single voltage schedule for Wanapum Substation 230 kV bus. PSEI interpreted the amendment as also allowing for the integration up to 300 MWs at GCPD's Wanapum Substation. Accordingly, PSEI posted a TTC value of 300 MWs for the Windridge-MIDCRemote path.

After discussions between PSEI and GCPD, on February 26, 2008 PSEI posted a document called Update of Windridge-MIDCRemote which no longer cited a TTC of 300 MWs. Accordingly, PSEI reduced the TTC on the Windridge-MIDCRemote path to 240 MWs.

Additionally, PSEI has posted a revised path name of Windridge-MIDC to align with scheduling and e-Tagging practices. The Windridge-MIDC path name will replace the Windridge-MIDCRemote path name.
