

## Within-Hour TSR Business Practice

Puget Sound Energy, the Transmission Service Provider, will adopt the following business practice to arrange for hourly non-firm transmission service for the current operating hour to meet the needs of the changing operating environment. This practice will be effective June 1, 2009.

- Requests for hourly non-firm transmission service received later than 2:00 p.m. (Pacific time) of the last Working Day (i.e., the days Monday through Friday, excluding any prescheduling holiday observed by the Western Electricity Coordinating Council) prior to the day service is scheduled to commence will be accommodated if practicable.
- A Transmission Customer (“TC”) requesting hourly non-firm transmission service within the current operating hour for a period that begins within such current operating hour will submit a “Within-Hour TSR”.
- Within-Hour TSRs must be submitted through the OASIS as follows:
  - TC requests an appropriate Within-Hour transmission service product:
    - Hourly Secondary Network
    - Hourly NF (PTP)
    - Secondary PTP
  - The TSR **must be pre-confirmed.**
  - TSR start and stop times must be whole clock hours such as xx:00.
  - TSR start time must be xx:00 of the current operating hour. For example, a Within-Hour request submitted at 8:12 would have a start time of 08:00.
  - TSR stop time must be at least the next operating hour. For example, a Within-Hour request submitted at 8:12 would have a stop time of at least 09:00.
  - No price negotiations will be allowed.
- Puget Sound Energy reserves the right to suspend this business practice without prior notice if reliability is impacted. Any such suspension will be posted within 24 hours.
