Dear Secretary Bose:

South Carolina Electric & Gas Company (“SCE&G”) hereby submits for filing with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”) a non-substantive, ministerial revision to correct a typo in Attachment F of the electronic version of SCE&G’s open access transmission tariff (“OATT”) as maintained in the Commission’s eTariff system. This request is administrative in nature, merely correcting a typo, and does not change the content of the SCE&G OATT. SCE&G respectfully requests that the Commission accept this filing without modifications or conditions.¹

SCE&G is serving an electronic copy of this filing via email on all of its OATT customers, the Public Service Commission of South Carolina, and the South Carolina Office of Regulatory Staff.

IV. Discussion

SCE&G recently became aware of a typo in Attachment F of its OATT as approved by the Commission. Specifically, Section 7.0 of Attachment F of SCE&G's OATT, as approved by letter order dated June 19, 2009, in Docket No. ER09-1047-000, states: "Nothing contained herein shall be construed as affecting in any way" (emphasis added). In contrast, Section 7.0 of Attachment F of SCE&G's OATT that is available through the Commission's eTariff system states: "Nothing contained herein shall be constructed as affecting in any way" (emphasis added). SCE&G merely seeks to correct this inadvertent typo. Thus, SCE&G is hereby making one correction to its eTariff OATT to make it consistent with the Commission-approved OATT.
