



## **Implement Mechanism to Post Narratives Regarding ATC Changes**

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**Effective Date: July 13, 2007**

**Revision #: 3**

In compliance with FERC Order No. 890 ¶ 369 and 18 CFR 37.6(b)(3)(i)(C)(3), TTC for all paths are reviewed at least on a monthly basis by system engineers for NPC and SPPC.

Within the month, TTC can change when one of the following occurs:

- a) New facilities have been added to a path.
- b) New facilities electrically near a path have been added.
- c) Large increases or decreases in load have occurred near a path.
- d) Existing facilities on a path have been removed or have been subject to a forced outage.
- e) Existing facilities electrically near a path have been removed or have been subject to a forced outage.

If any of these events have occurred, the path is re-analyzed with the updated model. If there is a change in TTC it is inserted into the OASIS site.

When TTC is changed, the ATC values will be updated automatically by the OATI system and displayed for all transmission customers to see on the OASIS. A brief, but specific, narrative explanation will be posted of the reason for a change in monthly and yearly ATC value changes as a result of a 10 percent change in TTC in either the Outages folder area or the OASIS Notices ATC/TTC Monitor Summary of OASIS home page, depending the reason.

Non-Outage Narratives are located in the following location:
