Queue Processing for Point-to-Point Transmission Requests

1 General

- 1.1 Point-to-Point transmission requests will be processed on a first-come first-served basis subject to exceptions based on the SRP Tariff, NAESB rules, and SRP Business Practices.
- 1.2 Long-Term Point-to-Point requests of type Original or Redirect will be processed entirely on a first-come first-served basis unless they are competing with a Renewal request which has specific rights pursuant to Rollover rules in Section 2.2 of the SRP Tariff and SRP Business Practices.
- 1.3 SRP does not use a Simultaneous Submission Window for processing transmission requests.

2 Request Timing

- 2.1 The timing table for submittal of and response to transmission service requests may be viewed on OASIS under the Data, Trans-Serv menu items by selecting the 'Service Timing' button.
- 2.2 A Yearly request that SRP deems to be a Competing Request under SRP's Rollover business practice may not be processed within the 60 day timeline.

3 ATC

- 3.1 Transmission requests are evaluated against the posted ATC at the time of processing.

4 Short-Term Competition

- 4.1 Short-Term Firm Confirmed reservations are Conditional (subject to displacement) up until the following deadlines:
 - 4.1.1 One hour before the start of Hourly transmission service
 - 4.1.2 One day before the start of Daily transmission service
 - 4.1.3 One week before the start of Weekly transmission service
 - 4.1.4 One month before the start of Monthly transmission service
- 4.2 Refer to NAESB "*Table 4-3 - Priorities for Competing Reservations and Requests*" to see the relative priority of different types of reservations.
- 4.3 In order to match a competing request, the Transmission Customer with the right of first refusal must agree to match or exceed duration, capacity, and price.

- 4.3.1 The Transmission Customer with a Short-Term Point-To-Point reservation will not be given the opportunity to match a Long-Term Firm Point-To-Point request.
- 4.4 SRP will not provide notice to the Transmission Customer of a conditional, Short-Term Firm Point-To-Point reservation that is displaced by a Long-Term Firm Point-To-Point request.
