Annulment Business Practice  
Effective October 1, 2006

Transmission Service Hourly-Secondary will not be Annulled. Hourly-Secondary services will be required to submit a transmission request with the request type of RELEASE in lieu of the annulment.

Transmission Services current procedures allow making annulments under the following conditions:

1. If the Transmission Provider (TP) accepts a reservation that has an error (i.e. incorrect Service Type: Network used incorrectly or Point-to-Point [PTP] used incorrectly)
2. If the Transmission Customer (TC) requests an annulment due to an error they have made (i.e. reserves on the wrong POR POD by accident) and will be replacing the reservation request with equal or greater MW and using the same Service Increment Type (i.e. Hourly PTP, Daily PTP, Secondary PTP).
3. Transmission Customer (TC) must contact the Transmission Provider (TP) within the following time limits if an error was made.

5 minutes after the “Queued Time” for request starting the next hour.  
30 minutes after the “Queued Time” for all other requests.

NOTE: A Use of Discretion Notice posting will be made within 24 hours when an annulment is made for this reason and posted for 90 days
