



Western Area Power Administration Rollover Rights Business Practice

In accordance with Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) Order Nos. 890, 890-A, and 890-B,¹ Western Area Power Administration's (Western) changes to the rollover rights provisions in section 2.2 of its revised Open Access Transmission Tariff (Tariff) do not become effective until such time as FERC accepts Western's Order No. 890 planning processes in its new Tariff Attachment P.² Until that time, Western will continue to apply the rollover rights provisions adopted in Order No. 888 – i.e., firm transmission service customers with a contract term of one year or more will have the right to continue to take transmission service from Western when the relevant contract expires, provided that the customer gives notice 60 days before expiration of the contract regarding whether it will exercise its right of first refusal.

After FERC accepts Western's Order No. 890 planning processes, Western will revise section 2.2 of its Tariff accordingly and will post a business practice explaining Western's implementation of the modified rollovers rights provisions adopted in Order No. 890.
