

## Procedure for Modification of Firm Point-to-Point Service on a Firm Basis

A Transmission Customer taking firm point-to-point transmission service may request a modification to the existing reservation at no additional cost. The modified request will be treated as a new firm transmission service request. While the modified request is pending and until it is confirmed by the Transmission Customer, the customer retains its rights under the original reservation. Any request submitted in accordance with Section 22.2 (Modifications on a Firm Basis) of the TVA Transmission Service Guidelines (Guidelines) must also meet the following requirements:

1. The modified firm request may be treated as a new request for firm transmission service under Attachment J of the Guidelines.
2. The new modified request must be submitted on a FIRM basis on OASIS.
3. The request type of the new modified request must be REDIRECT or it will be considered invalid.
4. The new modified request must include the OASIS number of the original reservation in the related reference field or it will be considered invalid.
5. The new modified request may include changes to POR, POD, Source, and/or Sink consistent with Attachment J of the Guidelines.
6. The new modified request may be for all or a portion of the original requested capacity and/or term of service.
7. The new modified request must match an existing type of firm point-to-point service (including start and end date requirements and early and late submission deadlines) or it will be considered invalid. For example, an existing yearly reservation can be modified only on a daily, weekly, monthly, or yearly basis.
8. If a short-term firm reservation is modified for a portion of the original requested capacity and/or term of service, the original reservation must already have been confirmed and have passed its preemption deadline. Prior to the preemption deadline, a short-term firm reservation may be modified only for the entire original requested capacity and term of service.
9. If a long-term firm reservation is modified for one year or longer and the Transmission Customer's new modified request extends until the end of the term of service of the original reservation, the new modified request must include a comment in the OASIS comment field informing TVA Transmission whether the right of first refusal in accordance with Section 2.2 of the Guidelines (Reservation Priority for Existing Firm Service Customers) is to be held on the original path or on the modified path. Failure to specify the rollover path will result in the right of first refusal being retained on the original reservation path by default. All Section 2.2 notification timing requirements remain in effect.

**Note:** If multiple new modified requests for different paths are submitted to modify or redirect the same (or substantially the same) portion of MWs for the same (or substantially the same) time period and each individually is capable of being accepted (but not more than one), TVA Transmission will ACCEPT the modified requests on all paths where ATC is available with a comment stating that only one of these requests may be confirmed by the Transmission Customer. Once the first of these multiple requests is CONFIRMED by the Transmission Customer, the remainder of the multiple requests will be DISPLACED by TVA Transmission.

**Note:** The submission and confirmation time limits and deadlines for a modified firm request are the same as those for a new firm request.
