

The MISO OASIS conversion to OATI's webOASIS system upgrades on April 15, 2013 includes significant rule and process changes.

Transmission Customers should take important note of the following:

- Pre-emption and competition,
- Simultaneous Submission Window (SSW) will change from prorated to lottery
- Attachment J timing for non-firm hourly service
